

FREDERIK BUYCKX WINS THE LIFE FRAMER SERIES AWARD, RECEIVING A SOLO EXHIBITION AT MATÈRIA GALLERY, ROME

We're happy to announce the result of the inaugural Life Framer Series Award - a prize designed to celebrate a single body of work alongside the main themed Life Framer Photography Prize.

The winner, selected by acclaimed fine-art photographer Mona Kuhn, is Frederik Buyckx with his series 'WOLF'. His series will be presented at a solo exhibition at Matèria Gallery in Rome from 8 June to 4 July 2017, curated by Life Framer and Matèria Gallery owner Niccolò Fano.

The series title - 'WOLF' - acts as a metaphor for his journey through the expansive landscapes of Europe, rediscovering wild nature and its inhabitants while in search of an antidote to a sterile life in the urban jungle.

Frederik says of it: "Putting yourself in the most uncomfortable situation is what makes you use all your senses to their fullest. I met the people and animals that still depend on nature, at the same time having to cope with its unpredictable character. Together with them I experienced what it is like to live with its forces.


To find these areas of isolation an wild nature I decided to follow the path of the wolf, a feared predator known for roaming through vast areas of wilderness. Strong but shy, the wolf doesn't often show itself to others, but others fear him. His presence can be felt rather than seen".



He received a Master's Degree in Advertising Design at St-Lucas Antwerp and studied photography until 2013 at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Ghent, Belgium, before becoming a freelance photographer in 2010. Besides assignments he mainly focuses on personal projects. For his series "Jesus, Make-Up and Football" he documented the daily life in the favelas in Rio de Janeiro.
